The modified accrual basis of accounting and governmental funds is used in the preparation of this budget. Revenue is recorded when susceptible to accrual and expenditures are recorded when the liability is incurred.

The District is responsible for the maintenance of landscaping in entrance and recreational areas. The District is also responsible for the maintenance and repair of sprinkler systems, outdoor signs, playground areas and equipment, tennis courts, equestrian trails and fences.

RESOLUTION OF EAST ARAPAHOE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT TO ADOPT BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of East Arapahoe Metropolitan District has appointed a budget committee to prepare and submit a proposed 2023 budget to the Board at the proper time; and

WHEREAS, such budget committee has submitted a proposed budget to this Board for its consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a designated place, and a public hearing was held on December 6, 2022, and interested electors were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, the budget has been prepared to comply with all terms, limitations and exemptions, including, but not limited to, reserve transfers and expenditure exemptions, under Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution ("TABOR") and other laws or obligations which are applicable to or binding upon District; and

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of East Arapahoe Metropolitan District:

1. That estimated expenditures are as follows:

- 3. That the budget, as submitted, amended and herein summarized by fund, be, and the same hereby is, approved and adopted as the budget of East Arapahoe Metropolitan District for the 2023 fiscal year.
- 4. That the budget, as hereby approved and adopted, shall be certified by the Treasurer and/or President of District to all appropriate agencies and is made a part of the public records of District.

TO SET MILL LEVIES

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses is \$49,402; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 valuation for assessment for District, as certified by the Arapahoe County Assessor, is \$5,045,158.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of East Arapahoe Metropolitan District:

- 1. That for the purposes of meeting all general operating expenses of the District during the 2023 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 9.792 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within District, to raise \$49,402 in revenue.
- 2. That the Treasurer and/or President of District is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Arapahoe County, Colorado, the mill levy for District as hereinabove determined and set.

TO APPROPRIATE SUMS OF MONEY

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of District has made provision therein for revenues in an amount equal to the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget; and

WHEREAS, it is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues provided in the budget to and for the purposes described below, as more fully set forth in the budget, including any interfund transfers listed therein, so as not to impair the operations of District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of East Arapahoe Metropolitan District that the following sums are hereby appropriated from the revenues of each fund, to each fund, for the purposes stated:
